Organism	Possible Infections or Diseases Related to the Microorganism
<i>Escherichia coli (E. coli)</i>	Urinary tract infections, infantile diarrhea
<i>Vancomycin Resistant Enterococcus faecalis (VRE)</i>	Nosocomial (hospital-acquired) infections of the urinary tract and infections occurring after abdominal surgery
<i>Staphylococcus aureus</i>	Skin lesions, boils, local infections, food poisoning, osteomyelitis
<i>Methicillin, Resistant Staphylococcus aureus (MRSA)</i>	Antibiotic resistant strain of <i>Staphylococcus aureus</i>
<i>Staphylococcus epidermidis</i>	Hospital acquired Bacteremia

<i>Klebsiella pneumoniae</i>	diarrhea, upper urinary tract infections, septicemia
<i>Pseudomonas aeruginosa</i>	Nosocomial infections of skin, respiratory, GI & urogenital tracts; infections associated with burns
<i>Pseudomonas cepacia</i>	Bacterial pneumonia in patients with Cystic Fibrosis, septicemia
<i>Streptococcus pneumoniae</i>	Bacterial pneumonia, bacterial meningitis, otitis media (ear infections), sinusitis, strep throat
<i>Serratia marcescens</i>	Nosocomial infections: Bacteremia, diarrhea
<i>Listeria monocytogenes</i>	Sepsis and bacterial meningitis in neonates, transplacental infection, conjunctivitis
<i>Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV)*</i>	Causes Acquired Immuno-Deficiency Syndrome (AIDS)
<i>Avian Flu A*</i>	Causes Avian Flu in birds
